

**AMENDMENT TO A SUBRECIPIENT GRANT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF OAK PARK AND BEYOND HUNGER**

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE SUBRECIPIENT GRANT AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as the “Amendment”) between the Village of Oak Park, an Illinois home rule municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the “Village”), and Beyond Hunger, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation (hereinafter referred to as “Grantee”) is entered into as of the effective date set forth below (collectively referred to as the “Parties”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into a Subrecipient Grant Agreement dated July 21, 2020 (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Parties seek to amend the Agreement pursuant to this Amendment to reflect a new total amount for the grant of \$115,158.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the Parties, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **RECITALS INCORPORATED.** The above recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

2. **AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT.** Section 3(A) of the Agreement is amended to add the following underlined language and delete the overstricken language to read as follows:

The Village shall distribute to Subrecipient as Subrecipient’s portion of the total grant received by the Village from HUD a maximum of ~~eighty-five~~ one hundred fifteen thousand, one hundred and fifty eight dollars ~~\$85,000.00~~ \$115,158.00 (hereinafter the “Grant Funds”) to be paid in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

3. **OTHER PROVISIONS OF THE AGREEMENTS TO REMAIN IN EFFECT.** All other terms and conditions of the Agreements shall remain in full force and effect.

4. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Amendment shall be effective as of June 21, 2022.
