A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ), OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS GRANT TO PREVENT OR REDUCE CRIME AND VIOLENCE AND TO INCREASE ACCESS TO JUSTICE

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, State of Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, that the Village Manager or the Village Manager's designee is authorized to submit a Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (JAG) grant application to increase access to justice, support crime victims and individuals impacted by the justice system, strengthen community safety, protect the public from crime and evolving threats, and build trust between law enforcement and the community.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
