#### CONTRACT ADDENDUM

This Contract Addendum is entered into on the 26 day of December, 2022 by and between Downtown Oak Park (DTOP), a not for profit corporation located at 1010 Lake Street, Oak Park, IL and Woodlawns Landscaping Company, Inc., 1190 S. Butterfield Rd., Mundelein, IL ("Contractor").

#### SECTION 1 - ADDENDUM

This Addendum is to a Landscape Services Agreement, between the parties dated December 26, 2022.

## **SECTION 2 - INSURANCE**

A. Contractor, at its sole expense, procure and maintain insurance for protection from claims under the Workers' Compensation Act and claims for bodily injury including personal injury, sickness, disease or death of any and all of its employees or of any person other than such employees, and from claims or damages because of injury to or destruction of property including loss of use resulting therefrom which may arise from the performance of its services under this Agreement in the following specified amounts:

- B. All insurance policies shall be issued by insurance companies licensed to do business in the state of Illinois and have a rating of not less than A VI, according to the latest edition of the A.M. Best Company Key Rating Guide.
- C. Contractor shall name the Village of Oak Park ("Village"), its officers, employees, agents and volunteers as additional insureds on all insurance policies set forth herein except workers' compensation. Contractor shall be responsible for the payment of any deductibles for those insurance policies. The coverage shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection afforded to the Village, its officers, employees, agents, and volunteers.

- D. The insurance protection required by this Agreement or otherwise provided by Contractor shall in no way limit its responsibility to indemnify, keep and save harmless, and defend the Village of Oak Park, its officers, employees, agents and volunteers as herein provided.
- E. Contractor shall provide the Village with a proper insurance certificate(s) showing the policy limits and coverage afforded the Village, and upon request, with certified copies of the policies or policy endorsements.

#### SECTION 3 - INDEMNIFICATION

- A. Contractor shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Village of Oak Park, or any of its officers, employees or agents from and against all liability, claims, demands, and causes of action arising out of or related to any loss, damage, injury, death, or loss or damage to property resulting from Contractor's error, omissions or negligent acts in its performance of the services, but not from the negligent acts of the Village.
- B. Contractor shall be responsible for any and all damages to property or persons and for any losses or costs to repair or remedy Village property as a result of its errors, omissions and/or negligent acts in the performance of its services.
- C. The indemnities set forth in this section shall not be limited by the insurance coverage required in Section 2 above.

#### SECTION 4 - INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

- A. Contractor is and shall remain for all purposes an independent contractor, and their officers, employees, or agents shall not be deemed employees of the Village of Oak Park.
- B. Contractor shall be solely responsible for any salaries, wages, benefits, fees or other compensation which it may obligate itself to pay to any of its employees or agents retained by the Contractor.

#### SECTION 5 - SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS; NO SUBCONTRACTORS

Contractor shall not subcontract, assign or transfer their interest or any part of the services in this Agreement without the written consent of the Village of Oak Park.

#### SECTION 6 - STANDARD OF CARE AND COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

- A. Contractor shall perform all of the provisions of this Agreement to the satisfaction of the Village of Oak Park. The Village shall base its determination of the Contractor's fulfillment of this obligation on accepted professional standards in the industry.
- B. Contractor shall comply with all federal, state, and local statutes, regulations, rules, ordinances, judicial decisions, and administrative rulings applicable to its performance of its services pursuant to this Agreement, including but not limited to, the Fair Labor Standards Act; any statutes regarding qualification to do business; any statutes

prohibiting discrimination because of, or requiring affirmative action based on race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, age, order of protection status, marital status, physical or mental disability, military status, sexual orientation, or unfavorable discharge from military service or other prohibited classification, including, without limitation, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. §§ 12101 *et seq.*, and the Illinois Human Rights Act, 775 ILCS 5/1-101 *et seq.* The Consultant shall also comply with all conditions of any federal, state, or local grant received by the Village or the Consultant with respect to this Agreement.

#### SECTION 7 - SAVINGS CLAUSE

If any provision of this Agreement, or the application of such provision, shall be rendered or declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of its requiring any steps, actions or results, the remaining parts or portions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

### SECTION 8 - CAPTIONS AND SECTION HEADINGS

Captions and section headings are for convenience only and are not a part of this Agreement and shall not be used in construing it.

## SECTION 9 - NON-WAIVER OF RIGHTS

No failure of any Party to exercise any power given to it hereunder or to insist upon strict compliance by any other Party with its obligations hereunder, and no custom or practice of the Parties at variance with the terms hereof, shall constitute a waiver of that Party's right to demand exact compliance with the terms hereof.

## SECTION 10 - BINDING AUTHORITY

The individuals executing this Agreement on behalf of the Parties represent that they have the legal power, right, and actual authority to bind their respective Party to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

### SECTION 11 - EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYER

Contractor shall be and remain an equal opportunity employer and the requirements of 44 III. Adm. Code 750 APPENDIX A are incorporated herein if applicable.

December 15, 2022 Landscape Maintenance

This agreement by and between DOWNTOWN OAK PARK (DTOP) and McADAM LANDSCAPING, Inc., 2001 Des Plaines Ave, Forest Park, IL for the following listed landscape services to be performed on Lake Street (Harlem to Forest), Marion Street (Ontario to North Blvd.), North Blvd. (North side of street, Harlem to Forest), Westgate, Maple between Lake and North Blvd., the perimeter of the parking garage located north of Lake Street between Marion and Harlem including garage planters on Harlem, Ontario (Marion Street to Holley Court Terrace), and between the public sidewalk and the buildings on the south side of Holley Court Terrace and the west side of the building, is entered into subject to the following:

#### SCOPE OF WORK

This proposal provides for the maintenance and care of all exterior landscaped areas, but specifically excludes paved areas, lights, fences and native trees unless authorized. This landscape maintenance program is designed to promote healthy growth and is defined in the following. It should be understood that unforseen and unpredictable occurrences such as storm damage and insect and disease problems do occur and they must be responded to. It is because of their unpredictable nature that we have omitted them from this proposal and would respond upon written authorization on a separate basis. This program does not include turf care.

#### PERIOD OF COVERAGE

This proposal shall provide for landscape maintenance services for the 2023 & 2024 seasons. Service begins approximately January 1, 2023.

#### SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED:

1. WATERING - All plant material will be watered sufficiently to maintain moist soil condition. The summer annual flowers in the round planters on Lake Street, Marion Street, North Blvd., and Westgate will be watered a minimum of once per week and as many as three times per week throughout the season depending on the conditions. The watering of plant material on Westgate and south Marion is also included. The automatic irrigation system on South Marion will be monitored and the frequency will be adjusted as conditions dictate.

2. SEASONAL FLOWERS - The annual flowers will be fertilized six(6) times throughout the season.

3. SIDEWALK SWEEPING - All sidewalks will be swept daily as needed Monday through Friday, April through November, picking up any litter such as papers, cans, bottles including litter found in planters. All debris and litter pick up will be done three times per week during the weekdays, December through March.

4. SIDEWALK WASHING - Sidewalks will be washed down with water once per week in front of the ice cream shop, the movie theater and around the benches throughout the summer months. Debris will be cleaned off walks.

5. SNOW- Cross walks will be shoveled and kept open after initial snow operations have been completed. This includes up to 12 occurrences throughout the winter season.

#### PLANTER BED MAINTENANCE

These areas contain no turf, but require weekly maintenance. Maintenance of these areas will be comprised of the following procedures:

#### Spring Clean Up

Remove all accumulated litter, winter debris, and leaves from planter beds, sidewalks, curb, and parking lot areas. Cut are herbaceous decorative grasses to approximately 2" above grade. Mulch all planting beds. New mulch areas must be four inches (4") deep, existing mulch areas must be refreshed with two inches (2"). Mulch must be premium double processed hardwood bark mulch natural in color. Hardwood bark mulch shall be clean, finely shredded mixed-hardwood bark, not to exceed two (2) inches in its largest dimension and free of foreign matter, sticks, stones and clods. All hardwood bark mulch shall be processed through a hammermill. Tree pits without tree grates should be mulched to grade. Inventory all damaged, diseased, or dead plants and submit list to the Forestry Superintendent.

#### Weed and Litter Control

Areas to be de-littered, weeded, and inspected weekly. All shrub and planting beds, flowerbeds, groundcover areas, tree rings, mulched and/or stone areas, planters and brick paver areas shall be kept weed free. All weed control treatment applications must be in conformance with the Village's Integrated Pest Management Plan. Apply **organic** non-selective weed control in parking, sidewalk, paved and paver areas as needed to keep these areas weed free with HOMEPLATE (EPA Reg. No. 67702-54-70051) or approved equivalent. Forestry Superintendent shall be notified prior to application of any control measures for material approval and scheduling. All applications to be made by licensed personnel. Cultivate planting beds as required to control weeds and define edges. Inspect plants for damage and correct as necessary.

#### Fertilization

Fertilize shrubs three (3) times per year at appropriate intervals with approved, balanced, complete analysis slow release fertilizer including micronutrients

#### Shrub Pruning

Prune or shear all deciduous shrubs two times per year during the growing season, evergreen shrubs once per year, cutting current year's growth unless otherwise directed. Prune and maintain ornamental ivy and/or groundcover as needed.

#### Fall Clean-up

Remove all leaves and fall debris from bed, parking areas and borders. Removed all spent material on herbaceous perennials to approximately 2" above grade except for decorative grasses.

#### Insect and Disease Monitoring

Accurately monitor and identify plant disease and insect pests. Notify the Forestry Superintendent of problems discovered and suggest treatment strategies. All applications for insect pest and disease control must have prior approval of Forestry Superintendent concerning timing, material used, and application method.

#### Tree Pit Weeding

The Village has trees located in pits with and without cast iron grates throughout its business districts. Pits are typically 5'x5' with double ground wood chips or gravel mulch. During the growing season, tree pit weeding is required to maintain a clean look within the business district. Weeding would involve the manual removal of all herbaceous material in the tree pit along with as much of its associated root system as possible. Chemical weed control may be used as necessary. All weed control treatment applications must be in conformance with the Village's Integrated Pest Management Plan. Apply **organic** non-selective weed control in parking, sidewalk, paved and paver areas as needed to keep these areas weed free with HOMEPLATE (EPA Reg. No. 67702-54-70051) or approved equivalent. Forestry Superintendent shall be notified prior to application of any control measures for material approval and scheduling. All applications to be made by licensed personnel.

#### Sidewalk and Curb Weeding

Sidewalk and curb areas to be inspected and weeded weekly. All sidewalk, stone, and paver areas shall be kept weed free. All weed control treatment applications must be in conformance with the Village's Integrated Pest Management Plan. Apply organic non-selective weed control in parking, sidewalk, paved and paver areas as needed to keep these areas weed free with HOMEPLATE (EPA Reg. No. 67702-54-70051) or approved equivalent. Forestry Superintendent shall be notified prior to application of any control measures for material approval and scheduling. All applications to be made by licensed personnel.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. All work shall be performed by trained, supervised personnel, in accordance with accepted horticultural practices.

- 2. Adequate personnel and equipment shall be provided to permit the timely completion of all operations.
- 3. An inspection of the landscape will be made each month and recommendations will be made if necessary.
- 4. Certificates of insurance shall be provided upon request prior to the commencement of work.

5. This Agreement shall not be assigned by the contractor without prior written consent of the owner.

6. Monthly invoice amount represents one- of a total twelve annual contract and is not necessarily representative of portion of landscape maintenance services rendered in any particular month.

7. Invoices for services rendered will be issued on a monthly basis. Payment is to be made within thirty (30) days from receipt of the invoice. A service charge of one and one half percent (1.5%) per month will be added to all past due balances. This represents an annual rate of eighteen percent (18%).

#### COMPENSATION

It is agreed and accepted that McAdam Landscaping Inc. is to be compensated per the terms and schedule outlined below. Monthly invoices of one twelve (1/12) the total annual contract does not necessarily represent the portion of landscape services rendered for any particular month. Payment is appreciated within thirty (30) days from receipt of the invoice. A service charge of one and one half percent (1.5%) per month may be added to all past due balances. This is an annual rate of eighteen percent (18%).

#### TWO-YEAR AGREEMENT

Services for the 2023 and 2024 seasons will be provided for the sum of \$48,192.00 per year for two years, payable in twenty-four (24) equal installments of \$4,016.00, beginning January 1, 2023 and monthly thereafter through December, 2024.

- A. Contractor shall perform all of the provisions of this Agreement to the satisfaction of the Village of Oak Park. The Village shall base its determination of the Contractor's fulfillment of this obligation on accepted professional standards in the industry.
- B. Contractor shall comply with all federal, state, and local statutes, regulations, rules, ordinances, judicial decisions, and administrative rulings applicable to its performance of its services pursuant to this Agreement, including but not limited to, the Fair Labor Standards Act; any statutes regarding qualification to do business; any statutes

prohibiting discrimination because of, or requiring affirmative action based on race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, age, order of protection status, marital status, physical or mental disability, military status, sexual orientation, or unfavorable discharge from military service or other prohibited classification, including, without limitation, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. §§ 12101 et seq., and the Illinois Human Rights Act, 775 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq. The Consultant shall also comply with all conditions of any federal, state, or local grant received by the Village or the Consultant with respect to this Agreement.

## SECTION 7 - SAVINGS CLAUSE

If any provision of this Agreement, or the application of such provision, shall be rendered or declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of its requiring any steps, actions or results, the remaining parts or portions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

# SECTION 8 - CAPTIONS AND SECTION HEADINGS

Captions and section headings are for convenience only and are not a part of this Agreement and shall not be used in construing it.

## SECTION 9 - NON-WAIVER OF RIGHTS

No failure of any Party to exercise any power given to it hereunder or to insist upon strict compliance by any other Party with its obligations hereunder, and no custom or practice of the Parties at variance with the terms hereof, shall constitute a waiver of that Party's right to demand exact compliance with the terms hereof.

## SECTION 10 - BINDING AUTHORITY

The individuals executing this Agreement on behalf of the Parties represent that they have the legal power, right, and actual authority to bind their respective Party to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

# SECTION 11 - EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYER

Contractor shall be and remain an equal opportunity employer and the requirements of 44 III. Adm. Code 750 APPENDIX A are incorporated herein if applicable.
