

## **RESOLUTION**

### **A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROGRAM YEAR (PY) 2020 ANNUAL PLAN FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANTS (CDBG) BY ADDING RETURNED FUNDS TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT CAPITAL BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Oak Park (“Village”) is an entitlement community under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and is therefore eligible to receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the 2020 program year; and

**WHEREAS**, as a condition of grant funding, the Village has submitted its 2020 Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and received approval; and

**WHEREAS**, any subsequent substantial changes to the 2020 Action Plan are subject to a public comment period prior to submittal to HUD for inclusion in the Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village proposes changing the 2020 Action Plan to allow the Village to use \$87,451 in returned CDBG funds from Program Year 2020.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees that the Village Manager or his designee is authorized to institute a 30-day public comment period on the proposed changes to the 2020 Action Plan, and, at the close of the 30-day comment period the Village Manager is authorized to transmit an Amended Action Plan with a summary of comments to HUD as required by HUD regulations barring any changes to the Amended Action Plan during that period.

**THIS RESOLUTION** shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
