### Time and Place of Opening of Bids

The Village of Oak Park -Office of the Village Engineer, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302 - will receive electronic proposals until **10:00 A.M. March 2, 2023.** Bids will be received and accepted, and bid results posted via the electronic VirtuBid™ online bid service.

### Description of Work

**Name:** 2023 Alley Improvements

**Location:** In general, this project will consist of improvements to various alleys throughout the Village of Oak Park. The alleys are located within the portion of town bound by North Ave on the north, Austin Blvd on the east, Harlem Ave on the west and Roosevelt Rd on the south. There are thirteen (13) different alleys which are planned to be constructed as a part of these improvements

**Proposed Improvement:** In general, the improvements consist of the removal of the existing alley pavements and garage aprons; installation of storm sewers and drainage structures; installation of aggregate base course; installation of concrete alley pavements and garage aprons; parkway restoration; and all appurtenant work thereto.

### Bidders Instructions

1. Contractors must purchase bid documents and be shown on the Bidder's Planholder List in order to bid. Bids received from contractors who are not in the Bidder's Planholder List will be rejected. The Village of Oak Park reserves the right to issue plans and specifications only to those contractors deemed qualified. All prospective bidders must prove they are pre-qualified by the Illinois Department of Transportation, or other approved Federal agency, by providing a certificate of eligibility to the Engineering Division

at which time a password will be issued for access to the online bid documents. No plans will be issued to prospective bidders after **4 P.M.** on the working day preceding the opening of bids. The electronic VirtuBid™ online bidding platform for this specific project will be opened approximately one week prior to the bid opening date.

2. At the bid opening, all proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the amount of 5% of the bid amount. The proposal guaranty shall be in the form of a bid bond executed by a corporate surety company or a bank cashier's check. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute an agreement and contract bond within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award, it is hereby agreed that the bid bond or check shall be forfeited to the Village.
3. The awarding authority reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals as provided in Article 102.01 of the 2022 "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," prepared by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
4. The work to be performed pursuant to this Proposal is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq.

6. In addition to Local funds, this project is partially financed with federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and thus is subject to all federal rules, regulations and guidelines.
7. Phasing of Contract: There are two separate phases of the contract – the Non-Federally funded phase (Phase I) and the Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Phase (Phase II):

The Contractor shall pay not less than the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for work of a similar character on public works in Cook County, Illinois, and not less than the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for legal holiday and overtime work, to all laborers, workers, and mechanics, employed on this project for Phase I. The Contractor shall comply with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act for Phase I work.

Phase II of the project shall include all work on alleys 307, 608, and 608-N as shown on the contract plans. The Contractor shall track all labor and materials for the CDBG funded work in Phase II separately from the non-federally funded work in Phase I. The Contractor shall follow all Federal rules, regulations and guidelines when working on Phase II of the project, including Davis Bacon and Related Acts.

Please note that all contractors awarded the contract (and their subcontractors) will receive no payouts from the village until documents submitted have been reviewed and approved and all federal requirements have been met
