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Agenda Item Title

A Resolution Approving an Amendment to the Subrecipient Grant Agreement Between the Village of Oak Park and United Cerebral Palsy Seguin of Greater Chicago and Authorizing its Execution

Overview

On September 20, 2021, the Village approved a motion to allocate \$33,000 in CDBG Public Facility Improvement funds for United Cerebral Palsy (UCP) Seguin of Greater Chicago for PY2021. After completing the scope of work outlined in the PY21 Agreement there is a remaining balance of \$4,680 unspent funds. UCP Seguin is requesting to add to the scope of work to spend down the balance of allocated funds.

Recommendation

Adopt the Resolution.

Fiscal Impact

This agenda item has no impact on the Village's General Revenue Fund.

Background

On September 20, 2021, the Village approved a motion to allocate \$33,000 in CDBG Public Facility Improvement funds for UCP Seguin of Greater Chicago for PY2021. After completing the original scope of work outlined in the PY21 Agreement there is a remaining balance of \$4,680 unspent funds. UCP Seguin of Greater Chicago has requested to amend the original scope of work to include the replacement of the three (3) existing windows and one (1) front entry door with the remaining \$4,680 to an Oak Park Community Integrated Living Arrangement (CILA) home for individuals with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities. All work would be completed in PY2021.

Alternatives

Previous Board Action

On September 20, 2021, the Village approved \$33,000 in CDBG Public Facility Improvement funds for UCP Seguin.

Citizen Advisory Commission Action

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The Community Development Citizen Advisory Commission has reviewed this initial application and approved funding in 2021 and Village Staff will provide an update.

Anticipated Future Actions/Commitments

After the Board adopts the Resolution, an update will be submitted to HUD.
