Agenda Item Title

A Resolution Approving a Purchase Price Agreement with Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC for Stone and Sand Materials in an Amount Not to Exceed \$30,000.00 and Authorizing its Execution

Overview

The Water and Sewer Division of the Public Works Department is responsible for maintaining the water distribution and sewer collection systems in the Village. The department annually seeks competitive bids for stone & sand materials.

Recommendation

Approve the Resolution.

Fiscal Impact

The proposed Fiscal Year 2023 Water and Sewer Fund Budget allocates funds for stone & sand materials for roadway maintenance of the water distribution and sewer collection systems in the Roadway Maintenance account, numbers 5040-43730-777-560633 (\$35,000.00) and 5040-43750-781-560633 (\$30,000.00).

Based on the bid summary and the estimate of materials needed, staff anticipates spending up to an amount of \$30,000.00 of the total \$65,000.00 with Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC.

Background

Four vendors provided material price bids for 2023. The materials are purchased from the lowest cost qualified vendor based on the availability and quality of the material. Staff is bringing forward agreements with vendors that exceed \$25,000.00, the Village Manager's spending authority.

Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC, has provided competitive pricing for these materials. Staff recommends approval of an agreement with Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC for the purchase of these materials with a not to exceed the amount of \$30,000.00.

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The Public Works Department brings this type of purchase agreement to the Village Board annually.
