Agenda Item Title

A Resolution Approving and Adopting the Village of Oak Park's Official Zoning Map

Overview

Annually, the Village is required to approve a map showing "the existing uses, divisions, restrictions, regulations and classifications" of property pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-13-19, as the official zoning map of the Village of Oak Park.

Recommendation

Approve the attached Zoning Map, as submitted.

Background

The Illinois Compiled State Statutes requires the approval (publication) of municipal zoning maps by March 31 st of each year, provided map changes were made. The Village of Oak Park Village Board is required to consider for approval a map showing "the existing uses, divisions, restrictions, regulations and classifications" of property in the Village pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-13-19, as the official zoning map of the Village.

In 2022 and early 2023, the changes that were made to the Village's zoning map, resulting in the need for consideration of this proposed resolution, include the following; 1.) Turano Bakery Planned Development expansion, 2.) Madison Common CoHousing Planned Development, and 3.) a Zoning Map Amendment for 327 -329 Home Avenue from the R5 Two Family Zoning classification to the R6 Multiple Family Zoning classification.
