WHEREAS, In the U.S. Zeke competed further police training in order to search for search for narcotics and he was trained to conduct building searches, area searches, protect his handler and as a result Zeke received certification in these categories from various organizations including the International Police Work Dog Association, the North American Police Work Dog Association and the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board; and

WHEREAS, Zeke and Officer Leitl completed monthly maintenance training with various Cook County area K9 Teams and throughout his career Zeke under the care and guidance of Officer Leitl multiple drug and money seizures assisting with investigations resulting in over \$1.7 million in money sniffs.
