A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) APPLICATION WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A PLANNING AND DEMONSTRATION PROJECT GRANT TO IMPLEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE VISION ZERO PLAN
