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2015 Alley Improvements

The Village has utilized a Consulting firm to perform subsurface investigations within the proposed alleys contained in this project. The firm has provided IEPA LPC-662 or 663 for all portions that were deemed satisfactory for CCDD landfills. Excavation from Alley 416-N (200 CY) and portions of Alleys 443 (100 CY) and 622 (100 CY) will need to be treated as Non-Special Waste.

The plan quantity was listed as 880 Cubic Yards. **This addendum will change the plan quantity to 400 Cubic Yards.**

The attached Schedule of Prices showing the revised quantity will need to be included with bid submittals.

Description of Work

Name: 2015 Alley Improvements— Oak Park Project # 15-4

Location: This project will consist of improvements to various alleys throughout the Village of Oak Park. The alleys are located within the portion of town bound by Roosevelt Road on the south, Austin on the East, Harlem Avenue on the west, and South Boulevard at the north. There are ten alley locations, some of which are “T” alleys, resulting in 15 directional alleys.

Proposed Improvement: The work to be performed will include excavation of existing alleys (typically PCC), installation of concrete alley pavement, intermittent concrete garage aprons, and restoration along the edges of the alley. Storm sewer improvements are included in the scope of this project, the degree of which will vary from alley to alley.

Bidders Instructions

1. Plans and proposal forms will be available in the Office of the Village Engineer, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302 upon payment of **\$40.00** (non-refundable). No plans will be issued to prospective bidders after **4 P.M.** on the working day preceding the opening of bids.
2. At the bid opening, all proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty, executed by a corporate surety company (bid bond) or a bank cashier's check in the amount of 5% of the amount bid.

3. The awarding authority reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals as provided in Article 102.01 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," prepared by the Department of Transportation.
