Below is a list of our most significant accomplishments in 2018 followed by our planned projects for 2019.

Accomplished in 2018

Project Name	Description
Shared Workstations	Communities no longer require their own GIS workstation and desktop software which collectively saves members \$379,500 on a 5-year amortization schedule.
Asset Management Solution	Five (5) standard solutions (apps) for collecting and editing infrastructure to improve data quality were adopted by 91% of members.
MGP Program Management Practices	In partnership with the GIS Consortium Executive Board, MGP formalized the program management and technical services support for every member.
Enterprise Address Verification Solution	The Address Verification solution compares and reports on address data from multiple community systems. This solution has been implemented across 100% of the membership.

Project Name	Description
MapOffice Future	We will be releasing the first version of the replacement for MapOffice 2.0.
Utility System Excellence Leveling	A system establishing levels of excellence for utility data quality will be completed.
GIS Audit Creation and Release	A management tool for City and Village Managers about GIS data quality will be released.
