Instructions for Agenda Public Comment

Comments are three minutes per person per agenda item with a maximum of three agenda items to which you can speak. Regular Agenda public comment will be limited to 15 minutes per agenda item. Public comment on any item for which a public hearing has taken place or for which a commission has made a recommendation is additionally limited to no more than five individuals commenting on each side of the issue.
