

Village of Oak Park Sign Code

Amendments 2022

- Sign Code was adopted in March 2009.
- Sign Code was last amended in September 2016.
- Public hearing for amendments are not required for Village Code articles.
- Community Design Commission work plan requires a year end review of the sign code.

Amendments

- Expand and clarify definition section.
- Remove requirement to provide public notice for a conference with the Community Design Commission.
- Added a requirement for an on-site posting of a sign variance.
- Updated DCS titles where appropriate.
- Prohibit outlining of buildings, windows or building features with all types of light sources.
- Added a clarification for temporary window signage covering during interior remodeling.
- Allowing temporary attention getting devices for special events and new business openings, with restrictions.
- Require all street side ground floor windows to be transparent, except for allowed window signage.
- Mirror projecting signs regulations for wall signs regulating internally illuminated signs must have opaque backgrounds – white or light colored background is prohibited.
