

VILLAGE OF OAK PARK

SINGLE-FAMILY HOUSING REHABILITATION GRANT PROGRAM AGREEMENT SFR-103

THIS AGREEMENT is made between the Village of Oak Park, an Illinois municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Village", and Miguel Aviles Peralta & Maria Carolina Ara, hereinafter referred to as "Owners".

WHEREAS, the Owners have made an application to the Village for a Lead Paint Hazard Reduction Grant in the amount of \$53,610.00, including a contingency of \$5,000, to be used for certain improvements to the Owner's residence located at 702 North Humphrey Avenue, Oak Park, County of Cook, State of Illinois, which residence is legally described as:

LOT 13 IN BLOCK 8 IN HOOKERS SUBDIVISION OF THE NORTHEAST ¼ OF THE SOUTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 13, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

Improvements: Specifications for the improvements are on file in the Neighborhood Services Department.

WHEREAS, the Village is desirous of making a Lead Paint Hazard Reduction Grant to the Owners for the construction of the improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual premises contained herein, it is agreed as follows: The Village will make a Lead Paint Hazard Reduction Grant to the Owners for the completion of the improvements on the subject property subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a) All of the construction and improvements shall be based on contracts with such contractors and in such form as approved by the Village.
- b) Upon approval of the contracts and contractors, the Village will disburse the funds directly to the contractors, subcontractors and materialmen upon presentation of Contractor's Sworn Statements and Waivers of Mechanic's and Materialmen's Liens in such forms as are satisfactory to the Village, upon the Owner's written authorization and upon an inspection of the work satisfactory to the Village. The Owners' funds committed to the project (if any) shall be disbursed prior to disbursement of any Village funds. Any Village funds committed to this project but not

disbursed shall revert to the Village.

c) In order to complete the improvements as quickly and as economically as possible, the parties understand and agree that, depending upon the scope and the nature of the work, a single contract may be awarded to a general contractor, or when appropriate, separate contracts may be awarded to various contractors for separate phases of the work. The latter method of individual advances will result in disbursing the proceeds of the total grant on a separate contract basis.

d) The Lead Paint Hazard Reduction Grant funds shall only be disbursed for work identified in the specifications as environmental rehab.

e) The Owners shall at all times while any sums hereunder remain unpaid maintain hazard insurance on the subject property in an amount which is at least 80% of the property's current market value. A policy insuring the Village's interest must be maintained in full force and effect throughout the full term of the grant. A copy of said policy must be provided to the Village prior to disbursement of any funds.

f) The grant amount shall include a contingency to cover any unforeseen conditions. If the entire approved amount of the grant including the contingency amount is not used, any remaining grant funds will not be disbursed and will remain unused.

j) Payment under any contract signed in connection with this grant is contingent upon approval by the Village of Oak Park Board of Trustees and/or the Village Manager.

k) The Owners agree to abide to all of the terms and conditions set forth in Exhibit I, attached hereto.
