

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A UNITED STATES CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION APPLICATION FOR A PUBLIC HEALTH ASSOCIATE TO ASSIST THE VILLAGE’S PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT WITH VIOLENCE AND INJURY PREVENTION PROGRAMS, HIV SURVEILLANCE BASED SERVICES AND OTHER HEALTH EDUCATION PROJECTS FROM OCTOBER 1, 2024 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, State of Illinois (“Village”), in the exercise of their home rule powers, that the submission of a 2024 application with the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for a Public Health Associate to assist the Village’s Public Health Department with violence and injury prevention programs, HIV surveillance based services and other health education projects from October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2026 is approved and the Village Manager or the Village’s Manager’s designee is authorized to execute the grant application and subsequent agreements subject to the review and approval of the Village Attorney.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval as provided by law.
