Elevate Experience in One-Stop Shop Program Design & Implementation



Green Homes Chicago – Full-service electrification retrofits for low-income single-family homeowners in Chicago



Evanston Green Homes Pilot – Health, safety, weatherization, and energy efficiency upgrades for single- and multi-family properties in climate-vulnerable communities



Madison (WI) Efficiency Navigator Program – One stop shop model to assist owners of small- to medium-sized naturally occurring affordable multifamily housing make energy and water improvements



City of Ann Arbor (MI) Bryant Neighborhood Decarbonization Project – Community-driven initiative aimed at transitioning the entire low-income Bryant neighborhood to carbon neutrality through home electrification, energy efficiency upgrades



Cook County Healthy Homes – Provides free whole-home upgrades including safety, energy efficiency, and water conservation improvements to low- and moderate-income households in suburban Cook County

Contract 1: Program Design

- July-September 2025
- Develop Operations Guide based on Best Practices & Stakeholder Feedback
- Contract 2: Program Management, Outreach, & Implementation
 - October-December 2025
 - Conduct energy assessments on 5-10 properties & develop customized Home Energy Roadmaps
 - Scale for expansion & continuous improvement
- Potential for Full Launch + Implementation in 2026

Task 1 (Months 1-2): Summarize of Best Practices & Lessons Learned

Task 2 (Months 1-2): Stakeholder Engagement Session w/ Key Stakeholders

- Gain feedback on program design from stakeholders at all levels, including:
- Volunteer Networks
- Faith Communities
- Multifamily property owners, homeowners & tenants of all income backgrounds (40% housing cost burdened)

Task 3 (Months 2-3): Finalize Design and Program Operations Manual

- Service Delivery & Help Desk Management
- Homeowner Education & Workshops/Materials
- Energy Assessments & Decarbonization Planning
- Contractor Training & Selection, Bulk Purchase Programs
- Performance Evaluation & Continuous Monitoring/Improvement

Key Deliverables & Scope: Program Management, Outreach, & Implementation (Contract 2)


Task 1 (Months 4-5): Program Implementation Soft Launch

- Conduct energy assessments for 5-10 properties

- Provide Help Desk support

Task 2 (Months 5-6): Scaled Implementation Plan + Recommended KPIs

- Solicit feedback on participant experience
- Analyze findings & patterns from roadmaps
- Report energy & cost reductions in addition to participant profile
