**Oak Park Project #18-2
2018 Street Resurfacing**

The barrier curb shall be placed upon a compacted crushed stone bedding, Gradation CA-6, having a minimum thickness of two inches (2"). The cost for the 2" stone cushion shall be included in this item.

Three smooth, round, epoxy coated, steel #4 dowel bars running the continuous length along each edge of the curb shall be placed at the location indicated on the details. At each corner where two curbs meet, a steel dowel bar ½" in diameter shall be bent to make a 90 degree angle and each side of the angle shall be one foot in length.

Between four (4) and twenty-four (24) hours after the curb has been placed, contraction joints two inches (2") in depth, shall be saw-cut at a maximum of a 15' spacing and at certain other locations as may be designated by the Engineer. These joints shall then be sealed according to the requirements of Article 420.14(a) of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction". At locations where the proposed curb meets existing curb, 2 - 18" long, ¾" diameter, epoxy coated, steel dowel bars shall be drilled into the existing curb.

After removal of the "back of curb" form, the excavated area behind the curb designated for sodding shall be immediately backfilled with select non-organic earth backfill in preparation for the placement of the topsoil. **All areas where concrete or asphalt is to be installed along the back of curb shall be backfilled with crushed stone, gradation CA-7 and properly compacted.** The costs for the placement of the required backfill material shall be included in the cost of the curb and gutter.

ONE INCH (1") THICK WOODEN FORMS WILL BE USED IN THE FORMING OF ALL RADIUS SECTIONS OF CURB AND GUTTER. MASONITE AND STEEL FORMS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.

Payment for this item shall be at the Contract unit price per Foot for CONCRETE CURB AND GUTTER, TYPE B.

ITEM 36- PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE SIDEWALK, 5"

This item includes the placement of new concrete sidewalk at locations shown on the Plans or as directed by the Engineer in accordance with Section 424 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction". The five inch (5") thick, P.C.C. sidewalk shall be constructed to the limits and grade required to blend with adjoining surfaces. The sidewalk shall be placed upon a base of compacted crushed stone, Gradation CA-6, having a minimum thickness of two inches (2"). Full depth expansion joints shall be placed between the sidewalk and the back of any adjacent curb, sidewalk, or buildings, and as directed by the Engineer.

Payment for this item shall be at the Contract unit price per Square Foot for PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE SIDEWALK, 5".

ITEM 37- DETECTABLE WARNING

This work shall consist of furnishing and installing detectable warnings as indicated on the contract plans in accordance with Section 424 of the Standard Specifications and as revised or amended in this special provision. The color shall be approved by Village prior to ordering.

Materials

Contractor shall have his choice of:

Cast Iron / Ductile Iron:

Detectable warnings shall have vent holes and be grey cast iron or ductile iron according to Article 1006. Fasteners shall be stainless steel according to Article 1006.29(d).

Plastic:

Detectable warning panels shall be anchor mounted (loops preferred). The panel shall have minimum thickness of ½ inch and flat bottom without fins to prevent air entrapment during installation.

Construction Requirements

Detectable warning tiles shall be mechanically connected to adjacent tiles with stainless steel bolts.

The Radial Tiles are required where the Setback is greater than 5 foot, and the rectangular tiles up to 2 by 5 foot are required where the Setback is equal or smaller than 5 foot. For the Setback refer to Curb Ramps For Sidewalks standards 424.

Submittals

- Submit manufacturer literature, installation procedures, drawings, and warranty.
- Submit two (2) tactile detectable warning wedge samples of the color proposed.
- Wet-Set (reusable) Radius Cast Iron (tactile) wedges shall be warranted in writing for a period of five (5) years.
- Warranty shall assure that wedges are free from defects from the date of purchase.

Detectable warnings will be measured for payment in place and the area computed in square feet.

Description of Work

Name: Oak Park Project # 18-2 Resurfacing of Various Streets

Location: This project will consist of improvements to various alleys streets the Village of Oak Park.

Proposed Improvement: In general, the improvements consist of the removal and replacement of curb and gutter, sidewalks, ADA ramps, driveways, minor drainage improvements, pavement patching, cold-milling of asphalt roadways, earth excavation, installation of hot-mix asphalt binder and surface courses, pavement striping, parkway restoration, and all appurtenant work thereto.

Bidders Instructions

1. Plans and proposal forms will be available in the Office of the Village Engineer, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302 upon payment of **\$50.00** (non-refundable). No plans will be issued to prospective bidders after **4 P.M.** on the working day preceding the opening of bids. Proposals will not be accepted by the Village of Oak Park from Contractors who have failed to provide payment, if required, for obtaining proposal forms and have also failed to register with the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department as plan holders for this project
2. At the bid opening, all proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the amount of 5% of the bid amount. The proposal guaranty shall be in the form of a bid bond executed by a corporate surety company or a bank cashier's check.

3. The awarding authority reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals as provided in Article 102.01 of the 2016 "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," prepared by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
4. The work to be performed pursuant to this Proposal is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq.

6. In addition to Local funds, this project is financed with federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and thus is subject to all federal rules, regulations and guidelines.
7. Phasing of Contract: There are two separate phases of the contract – the Non-Federally funded phase (Phase I) and the Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Phase (Phase II):

The Contractor shall pay not less than the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for work of a similar character on public works in Cook County, Illinois, and not less than the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for legal holiday and

overtime work, to all laborers, workers, and mechanics, employed on this project for Phase I. The Contractor shall comply with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act for Phase I work.

Phase II of the project shall include all work on both segments of Humphrey Avenue as shown on the contract plans. The Contractor shall track all labor and materials for the CDBG funded work in Phase II separately from the non-federally funded work in Phase I. The Contractor shall follow all Federal rules, regulations and guidelines when working on Phase II of the project, including Davis Bacon and Related Acts.

Please note that all contractors awarded the contract (and their subcontractors) will receive no payouts from the village until documents submitted have been reviewed and approved and all federal requirements have been met.

1. The plans for the proposed work are those prepared by Hancock Engineering, 9933 Roosevelt Road, Westchester, IL 60154.
2. The specifications referred to herein are those prepared by the Department of Transportation and designated as 2016 "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", revised April 1st, 2016, and the "Supplemental Specifications" there to, the "Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Construction in Illinois", and the "Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices", adopted and in effect on the date of invitation of bids.
3. Replace "the Department" with "The Village of Oak Park," and the term, "Regional Engineer" with "Village Engineer."
4. The undersigned agrees to accept, as part of the contract, the applicable Special Provisions indicated on the "Check Sheet for Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions" contained in this proposal.
5. The undersigned agrees to complete the work before **October 31st, 2018** unless additional time is granted in accordance with the specifications.
6. Accompanying this proposal is either a bid bond on the Village Bond form or a proposal guaranty check, complying with the specifications, made payable to the Village of Oak Park. The amount of the check is FIVE PERCENT BID BOND (\$ 5%).
7. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute a contract and contract bond as required, it is hereby agreed that the Bid Bond or check shall be forfeited to the awarding authority.
8. Each pay item should have a unit price and a total price.
9. The unit price shall govern if no total price is shown or if there is a discrepancy between the results of unit price multiplied by the quantity.
10. If a unit price is omitted, the total price will be divided by the quantity in order to establish a unit price.
11. A bid will be declared unacceptable if neither a unit price nor a total price is shown.
12. The undersigned firm certifies that it has not been convicted of bribery or attempting to bribe an officer or employee of the State of Illinois, nor has the firm made an admission of guilt of such

conduct which is a matter of record, nor has an official, agent, or employee of the firm committed bribery or attempted bribery on behalf of the firm and pursuant to the direction or authorization of a responsible official of the firm. The undersigned firm further certifies that it is not barred from bidding on this contract as a result of a conviction for the violation of State laws prohibiting bid-rigging or bid-rotating.
