Housing Provider Training – Code Current



- Amend Sect. 12-2-12: Annual Management Seminar
- Currently
 - Who
 - Owner or designated agent
 - When
 - Every year for current licensees
 - Within 1 year of issuance for new licensees

Housing Provider Training – Code Proposed

Who

- Anyone working with potential tenants (property owner, designated agent, marketing agents, etc.).
- Local agents required for out of town property owners

When

- At least annually for current licensees.
- Within 3 months of issuance for new licensees.

Other Code Revisions



Required information

- Provide tenants fair housing handouts
- Post application criteria on website, linked in listings, and in leasing offices
- Post Source of Income and Just Housing Amendment information on their website

Housing Provider Training – Approach



- Format and frequency
 - From remote to in-person
 - From three times a year to at least once a quarter
- Improve noticing and monitoring

• Engagement - role playing exercises

Housing Provider Training – Content



- Review and revise content annually
- Renting and Fair Housing in Oak Park
 - i. Fair Housing
 - ii.Just Housing Amendment: Protections & Process
- Rental Licensing and Inspections Ordinance
- RTLO: Rights, Remedies & Obligations
- Source of income
- Support from partners (OPHA, etc).

Tenant Resources



- Currently provide
 - Listening sessions
 - Lists of legal and housing resources
 - Mediation

- To add
 - Housing Provider/tenant handbook
 - Tenant resource fair
 - Fair housing handouts

Community education



Handouts to provided to tenants during property inspections

 Work with Communications to produce Public Service Announcements (PSA) about Fair Housing

Work with Neighborhood Partnerships to develop new resources

Fair Housing Coalition



- Start quarterly meetings of a Fair Housing Coalition by end of 2024
- Facilitated by Neighborhood Services with support from DEI
- Content initially will focus on:
 - Future testing/ training/ education needs
 - Feedback on Village program and policy changes
- Long term a space for identification and collaboration on actions by many parties

Future Fair Housing Testing / Training



- Work with Hope for balance of 2024 outreach/ engagement
 - November training on Source of Income

 - Source of income
 - Just Housing Amendment
 - ADA
 - Utility allowances
 - Race/ ethnicity
 - Familial status
 - Lending practices
