

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) APPLICATION WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AN IMPLEMENTATION GRANT TO IMPLEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE VISION ZERO PLAN FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS
