Time and Place of Opening of Bids

The Village of Oak Park—Office of the Village Engineer, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302—will receive electronic proposals until **Thursday, February 27, 2025 at 10:00 A.M.** Bids will be received and accepted, and bid results posted via electronic VirtuBid™ online bid service.

Description of Work

Name: Bridge Rehabilitation Program

Location: The Bridge Rehabilitation Program consists of four sites, including The Home Avenue pedestrian bridge, the Oak Park Avenue bridge, the East Avenue bridge, and the Lombard Avenue bridge. All bridges span I-290 in Oak Park, Illinois (Cook County)

Description: In general, the work includes deck slab repairs (full depth and partial depth), protective shielding installation, approach hot-mix asphalt removal and replacement, expansion joint replacement, concrete sidewalk and curb repairs, fence and railing repairs; and all appurtenant work thereto.

Bidders Instructions

1. Plans and proposal forms may be obtained via the electronic service starting on **Thursday, February 6th, at 4:00 P.M.**, which can be found at <https://www.oak-park.us/your-government/budget-purchasing/requests-proposals> or at www.questcdn.com under login using QuestCDN number **9510247** for a non-refundable charge of \$64.00. Contractors must purchase bid documents and be shown on the Bidder's Planholder List in order to bid. Bids received from contractors who are not in the Bidder's Planholder List will be rejected. The Village of Oak Park reserves the right to issue plans and specifications to only those contractors deemed qualified. No plans will be issued to prospective bidders after 4:00 P.M. on the working day preceding the opening of bids. The electronic VirtuBid™ online bidding platform for this specific project will be opened approximately one week prior to the bid opening date.
2. At the bid opening, all proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the amount of 5% of the bid amount. The proposal guaranty shall be in the form of a bid bond executed by a corporate surety company. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute an agreement and contract bond within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award, it is hereby agreed that the bid bond shall be forfeited to the Village.
3. The awarding authority reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals as provided in Article 102.01 of the latest edition of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," prepared by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

4. The work to be performed pursuant to this Proposal is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq.

1. The plans for the proposed work are those prepared by the Engineering Division of the Village of Oak Park, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois dated January 2025 or as modified by addenda.
2. The specifications referred to herein are those prepared by the Illinois Department of Transportation and designated as "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" (latest edition) and the "Supplemental Specifications" (latest edition) thereto, the "Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Construction in Illinois" (latest edition), and the "Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices" (latest edition), adopted and in effect on the date of invitation of bids.
