

<b>Community</b>	<b>Current Restrictions for Mobile Food Vendors</b>
<b>Oak Park</b>	Mobile food trucks must adhere to health and safety standards Temporary permits are required for operations at special events Restrictions on operating near certain public spaces
<b>Chicago</b>	Food trucks cannot operate within 200 feet of restaurants in certain zones Must have a handwashing sink and three-compartment sink with portable water under pressure Trucks are subject to health inspections
<b>Evanston</b>	Vendors must have a Mobile Food Vendor License Restrictions on parking and operation times in certain areas Compliance with health and safety regulations
<b>Oak Lawn</b>	Must have a health permit and meet health code requirements Restrictions on operating near schools, parks and residential zones Food trucks must have a grease trap and waste disposal plans
<b>Elk Grove Village</b>	Vendors must comply with health department regulations Food trucks are restricted from operating in residential areas Must obtain a business license and health inspection
<b>Berwyn</b>	Requires a mobile food vendor license Vendors must comply with health and safety standards Restrictions on operating in residential zones and near schools
<b>Cicero</b>	Food trucks must have health permits and pass inspections Vendors are restricted from operating near schools and in residential areas, without special permission Must comply with local zoning laws
<b>River Forest</b>	Vendors must have a valid permit to operate Restrictions on operating in residential areas Health and safety standards must be adhered to
<b>Downers Grove</b>	Food trucks must comply with local zoning and health codes Restrictions on where food trucks can park, cannot be near residential areas and schools
<b>Carol Stream</b>	Vendors must obtain a food establishment permit Restrictions on where trucks can operate, not in residential Must comply with health and sanitation regulations
<b>Arlington Heights</b>	Requires a mobile food vendor license Restrictions on operating in residential areas Must comply with health and sanitation regulations
<b>Addison</b>	Vendors must have a valid permit to operate Health inspections required Restrictions on where trucks can operate, not in residential
<b>LaGrange</b>	Food trucks must comply with local zoning laws Vendors must have health permits and pass regular inspections Restrictions on operating in residential areas
<b>Hinsdale</b>	Requires a mobile food vendor license Restrictions on operating in residential areas Vendors must comply with health and safety standards
<b>Melrose Park</b>	Mobile food trucks must obtain a permit from the Village Must comply with health and sanitation regulations Regulations on operating in residential areas, unless they've obtained a special permit Vendors must have a waste disposal plan
<b>Elmwood Park</b>	Must comply with health and sanitation regulations Cannot operate within 1,000 feet of any restaurant or Village event Must comply with health and sanitation regulations
