A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS GRANT APPLICATION TO PREVENT OR REDUCE CRIME AND VIOLENCE AND TO IMPROVE THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, State of Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, that the Village Manager or the Village Manager’s designee is authorized to submit a United States Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs grant application that increases access to justice, supports crime victims and individuals impacted by the justice system, strengthens community safety, protects the public from crime and evolving threats, and builds trust between law enforcement and the community and authorizing the execution of any agreements related to the grant subject to the review and approval of the Village Attorney.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
