

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE ENFORCEMENT OF SECTION 15-1-4 (“TRUCKS AND BUSES PROHIBITED, LOCATIONS”) OF THE OAK PARK VILLAGE CODE TO ALLOW TRUCK TRAFFIC ON CHICAGO AVENUE UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2026 IN THE VILLAGE OF OAK PARK

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 15-1-4 (“Trucks and Buses Prohibited, Locations”) of the Oak Park Village Code, the Village is authorized to prohibit operating a truck on certain streets within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that a temporary moratorium on the enforcement of Section 15-1-4 of Village Code on Chicago Avenue through December 31, 2026, or until such time as the detours for the Oak Park Avenue Streetscape improvements are no longer in effect, whichever comes first, is necessary to allow truck traffic on Chicago Avenue due to road closures and construction on Oak Park Avenue; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, County of Cook, Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The above recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance and shall have the same force and effect as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Temporary Moratorium and Duration. The Village declares and establishes a temporary moratorium on the effectiveness of Section 15-1-4 (“Trucks and Buses Prohibited, Locations”) of the Oak Park Village Code with regard to prohibiting trucks on Chicago Avenue. The temporary moratorium established by this Ordinance shall allow the Village to permit trucks on Chicago Avenue due to road closures and construction on Oak Park Avenue through December 31, 2026, or until such time as the detours for the Oak Park Avenue Streetscape improvements are no longer in effect, whichever comes first, unless the Village rescinds or extends the temporary moratorium pursuant to a subsequent ordinance.

Section 3. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date and Sunset. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval, passage and publication as provided by law through December 31, 2026 or

until such time as the detours for the Oak Park Avenue Streetscape improvements are no longer in effect, whichever comes first, unless the Village rescinds or extends the moratorium pursuant to a subsequent ordinance.
