

**RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (IDOT) SUSTAINED TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP) GRANT APPLICATION THAT FOCUSES ON HIGH VISIBILITY TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT DURING SPECIFIC DATES AND TIMES OF THE YEAR, PRIMARILY AROUND NATIONAL HOLIDAYS.**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, State of Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, that the Interim Village Manager or the Interim Village Manager’s designee is authorized to submit an Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Sustained Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant application that focuses on high visibility traffic enforcement during specific dates and times of the year, primarily around national holidays.
