CONCEPT DESIGN

Our initial concept is a series of lit archways, fabricated into 12 8' x 12' aluminum panels. Each panel could be installed using the previous steel frame and removing every other column.

Panels will be painted (detailed on page 5)





MATERIALS

Panels would be fabricated from 0.040" aluminum.

Archways would be painted white and lit from below with programmable LED panels that will shine upwards into the arch. The arches would have a combination of colors, some having 2-3 channels within the arch with separate colors for each.

LED panels will be programmable for different color displays whenever needed. Christmas (red + green), Cinco de Mayo (red + green + yellow), St. Patricks Day (shades of green), etc.








Color Variances
