Time and Place of Opening of Bids

The Village of Oak Park – Office of the Village Engineer, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302 – will receive electronic proposals until **10:00 A.M. March 6, 2025**. Bids will be received and accepted, and bid results posted via the electronic VirtuBid™ online bid service.

Description of Work

Name: 2025 Alley Improvements

Location: In general, this project will consist of improvements to various alleys throughout the Village of Oak Park. The alleys are located within the portion of town bound by North Ave on the north, Austin Blvd on the east, Harlem Ave on the west and Roosevelt Rd on the south. There are approximately twenty (20) different alley segments which are planned to be constructed as a part of these improvements.

Proposed Improvement: In general, the improvements consist of the removal of the existing alley pavements and garage aprons; installation of storm sewers and drainage structures; installation of aggregate base course; installation of concrete alley pavements, installation of garage aprons; parkway restoration; and all appurtenant work thereto.

Bidders Instructions

1. Plans and proposal forms may be obtained via the electronic service starting on February 13th, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. Plans and proposal forms can be found at <https://www.oak-park.us/your-government/budget-purchasing/requests-proposals> or at www.questcdn.com under login using QuestCDN number 9507011 for a non-refundable charge of \$64.00. Contractors must purchase bid documents and be shown on the Bidder's Planholder List in order to bid. Bids received from contractors who are not in the Bidder's Planholder List will be rejected. The Village of Oak Park reserves the right to issue plans and specifications only to those contractors deemed qualified. All prospective bidders must prove they are pre-qualified by the Illinois Department of

Transportation, or other approved Federal agency, by providing a certificate of eligibility to the Engineering Division at which time a password will be issued for access to the online bid documents. No plans will be issued to prospective bidders after **4 P.M.** on the working day preceding the opening of bids. The electronic VirtuBid™ online bidding platform for this specific project will be opened approximately one week prior to the bid opening date.

2. At the bid opening, all proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the amount of 5% of the bid amount. The proposal guaranty shall be in the form of a bid bond executed by a corporate surety company or a bank cashier's check. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute an agreement and contract bond within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award, it is hereby agreed that the bid bond or check shall be forfeited to the Village.
3. The awarding authority reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals as provided in Article 102.01 of the 2022 "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," prepared by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
4. The work to be performed pursuant to this Proposal is subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq.
5. Bidders need not return the entire proposal when bids are submitted to the online electronic bidding service. Portions of the proposal that must be uploaded are indicated below include the following:

7. This project is also financed with federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and thus is subject to all federal rules, regulations and guidelines, including Davis-Bacon and Related Acts, Section 3, and Equal Opportunity requirements. Four alley segments will be funded through CDBG and these alley segments shall be paid for based on agreed unit prices. **However, the Village reserves the right to remove any or all of these alley segments from the project if access to the allocated CDBG funds is restricted or unavailable.**
8. This Contract will be subject to the requirements set forth in IDOT Circular Letter 2023-30 "BUILD AMERICA / BUY AMERICA ACT (BABA) - FINAL RULE." This law requires certain materials to be manufactured and produced in America. The current list of construction materials subject to BABA may be found on IDOT's website at: <https://idot.illinois.gov/doing-business/material-approvals/idot-material-labs/metals---miscellaneous/references.html>
Note, PVC pipe is included on this list.
9. The Contractor shall pay not less than the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for work of a similar character on public works in Cook County, Illinois, and not less than the general prevailing rate of hourly wages for legal holiday and overtime work, to all laborers, workers, and mechanics, employed on this project. The Contractor shall comply with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act.

The Contractor shall track all labor and materials for the CDBG funded from any non-federally funded work. The Contractor shall follow all Federal rules, regulations and guidelines, including Davis-Bacon and Related Acts.

Note: Proposal Guaranty Checks or Proposal Bid Bonds should be uploaded to the Qualification Information section of the online electronic bidding system.

Please note that all contractors awarded the contract (and their subcontractors) will receive no payouts from the village until documents submitted have been reviewed and approved and all federal requirements have been met.

1. The plans for the proposed work are those prepared by Hancock Engineering., 9933 Roosevelt Rd, Westchester, IL.
2. The specifications referred to herein are those prepared by the Department of Transportation and designated as 2022 "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" and the "Supplemental Specifications" there to, the "Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Construction in Illinois", and the "Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices", adopted and in effect on the date of invitation of bids.
3. The undersigned agrees to complete all work before the date of **July 15, 2025** unless additional time is granted in accordance with the specifications.
4. Accompanying this proposal is a bid bond on the Village Bond form, complying with the specifications, made payable to the Village of Oak Park.
5. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute a contract and contract bond as required, it is hereby agreed that the Bid Bond or check shall be forfeited to the awarding authority.
6. Each pay item should have a unit price and a total price. The unit price shall govern if no total price is shown or if there is a discrepancy between the results of unit price multiplied by the quantity. If a unit price is omitted, the total price will be divided by the quantity in order to establish a unit price.
7. A bid will be declared unacceptable if neither a unit price nor a total price is shown.
8. The undersigned firm certifies that it has not been convicted of bribery or attempting to bribe an officer or employee of the State of Illinois, nor has the firm made an admission of guilt of such conduct which is a matter of record, nor has an official, agent, or employee of the firm committed bribery or attempted bribery on behalf of the firm and pursuant to the direction or authorization of a responsible official of the firm.
