## Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide data on the field contact cards for 2025 (01JAN – 31DEC 2025).

## Background

There were 569 field contact cards: 473 were Calls for Service (CFS) and 96 were Self-Initiated Stops (SI), resulting in 101 arrests. Below is the summary of data for each month and attached is an Excel Spreadsheet with the details of each contact.

In **January**, there were 26 field contact cards in response to 17 incidents, with multiple individuals stopped on 14JAN2025 at 745 Garfield St. Additionally, seven arrests were made:
