

Summary of Equipment Restricti A-47-4

- Adopted in spring 2023
- Phase approach to ban
 - Not permitted June 1 to September 30 in 2023 and 2024
- Full ban beginning June 1, 2025





Summary of Equipment Restricti A-47-4



Applies to:

- Property owner using a gas-powered leaf blower.
- Business owner using a gas-powered leaf blower.
- Landscaper using a gas-powered leaf blower.
- Property owner who has hired and is permitting a landscaper to use the gaspowered leaf blower on their yard.





Summary of Equipment Restricti

- SIALIS

- Electric leaf blower permitted
 - Mon-Fri 8AM to 6PM
 - Sat & Sun 9AM to 4PM
- Maximum decibel level 65
- Contractor Registration Required
