## **General Business Fees:**

Fee based on square footage: Any business not specifically identified in subsection 8-2-1B of this section with a permanent location in Oak Park shall pay a general business license fee based on the number of square feet of occupied space according to the following table.

0 - 1,999 square feet	\$100
2,000 - 4,999 square feet	\$150
5,000 - 7,999 square feet	\$200
8,000+ square feet	\$250

## Food Establishments:

In addition to the general business license fee set forth in subsection 8-2-1C1 of this section, all food establishments, as defined in section 8-24-1 of this chapter, adult daycare facilities and pharmacies with food sales which are not specifically identified in subsection 8-2-1B of this section, shall be charged a food establishment fee as follows:

Category I (low risk) food establishments	\$240
Category II (medium risk) food establishments	\$420
Category III (high risk) food establishments	\$540
