Brief History Of the Youth Engagement Program IGA

- The Youth Engagement Program (formerly the Youth Interventionist Program) started in 1996 as a collaboration between all 11 taxing bodies in Oak Park and River Forest to address youth gang involvement, substance abuse and violence in the communities. Currently 9 taxing bodies support the program (10 if the Village signs on).
- In 2019 the program shifted models and become focused on Youth Mental Health. The program hired Masters Level Social Workers and clinical supervision was provided by the Director (a Licensed Clinical Social Worker: LCSW). Program Manager also a LCSW as of 2021.
- In 2022 the program changed names based on community feedback from partners, youth, and families to the Youth Engagement Program to be more in sync with the services provided, which is FREE MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING for youth.

 - Consulting around youth needs
