

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TERMINATING SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER EIGHT

WHEREAS, an ordinance establishing Special Service Area Number Eight in the Village of Oak Park (“SSA #8”) was adopted on June 4, 2018, for the purpose of providing special municipal services to the area bounded by both the east and west sides of the 1200 Block of North East Avenue, the east and west sides of the 1200 Block of Columbian Avenue, the east and west sides of the 1200 block of Linden Avenue, and the east and west sides of North Euclid Avenue from Lemoyne Parkway, north to the alley immediately south of North Avenue, with the residential addresses included in the range of 1200 through 1235 inclusive, in addition to services provided to the Village generally; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is to terminate SSA #8.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth.

Section 2. Termination. The special service area established by Ordinance 18-329, being an Ordinance Establishing SSA #8, is hereby terminated as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Recording and Filing of Ordinance. The Village Attorney or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to record a copy of this Ordinance terminating SSA #8 with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds and provide a copy of this Ordinance to the Cook County Clerk.

Section 4. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval, passage and publication as provided by law.
