The Village of Oak Park --Office of the Village Engineer, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302-- will receive electronic proposals until **11:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 11, 2021** for Project: 21-5, Oak Park Public Work's Rain Garden. Bids will be received and accepted, and bid results posted via electronic VirtuBid™ online bid service.

### Description of Work

Name: Oak Park Public Work's Rain Garden

In general, the improvements consist of site grading and excavation, erosion control, installing amended soils and gravel pathways, installing landscape plantings for creating a rain garden, and all appurtenant work thereto.

The Village of Oak Park reserves the right to issue plans and specifications only to those contractors deemed qualified. No bid documents will be issued after 4:00 p.m. on the working day preceding the date of bid opening. The electronic VirtuBid™ online bidding platform for this specific project will be opened approximately one week prior to the bid opening date.
2. At the bid opening, all proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the amount of 5% of the bid amount. The proposal guaranty shall be in the form of a bid bond executed by a corporate surety company or a bank cashier's check.

3. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute an agreement and contract bond within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award, it is hereby agreed that the bid bond or check shall be forfeited to the Village.
