SUBJECT: 24-Hour Retail Goods Establishments Analysis Update

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide the Village Board with information on violent criminal offenses that have occurred at 24-hour retail goods establishments from January 1, 2019 through July 29, 2022.

The tables below provide a summary of such offenses that occurred at the two (2) 24-hour retail goods establishments located in the Village. All offenses involving or implying the use of a firearm are **bolded** in the tables. Five (5) of the twelve (12) offenses occurred between the hours of 12:00AM and 5:00PM.
