

Background






Dr. Percy Julian - OP Walk of Fame




Dr. Percy Julian - OP Walk of Fame




Dr. Percy Julian - Branded Corridor

- Limitations and Exceptions






Framework (cont'd)

 - Village Board maintains authority to provide partial or full funding






Framework - Markers & Public Art




