A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) BUILDING RESILIENT INFRASTRUCTURE AND COMMUNITIES DIRECT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE (BRIC DTA) GRANT APPLICATION FOR A BENEFIT TO COST ANALYSIS FOR THE LOMBARD AVENUE RELIEF SEWER PROJECT
