

RESOLUTION

Village of Oak Park Historic Preservation Commission

WHEREAS, 1144 Lake Street, LLC (hereinafter referred to as “applicant”) filed an application for Cook County Class L status with the Historic Preservation Commission (hereinafter referred to as “Commission”) for a commercial building rehabilitation and tenant buildout for Barnes & Noble bookstore at **1144 Lake Street**, Oak Park, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Asha Andriana, Acting Chair of the Historic Preservation Commission, scheduled the application for review at the regularly scheduled Historic Preservation Commission meeting of October 23, 2025; and

WHEREAS, at that regularly scheduled meeting the Historic Preservation Commission unanimously determined That the project budget and scope of work as approved meet or exceed the Secretary of the Interior’s Standards for the Rehabilitation of historic properties.

Now, therefore, it is hereby resolved that this Historic Preservation Commission, acting under and by virtue of the authority conferred upon it by the Ordinance of the Village of Oak Park, does hereby recommend to the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park that the commercial property located at **1144 Lake Street** be supported in their application to the Cook County Board for the granting of a Class L designation.
