Non-agenda public comment will be limited to 30 minutes with a limit of three minutes per person. If comment requests exceed 30 minutes, public comment will resume after the items listed under the regular agenda are complete.

In addition, the Village Board permits a maximum of three persons to speak to each side of any one topic that is scheduled for or has been the subject of a public hearing by a designated hearing body. A. RES 20-120 A Resolution Declaring and Emergency Affecting Public Health Due to the

Outbreak of the COVID-19 Disease in the State of Illinois

<u>Overview:</u> The Village Board is asked to declare a local public health emergency, a

procedural step under state law to respond to rapidly changing challenges of the novel coronavirus disease, COVID-19. Both the State of Illinois and Cook County have already taken such action, and staff is recommending the Village

do the same.

B. ORD 20-030 An Ordinance Amending Chapter 2 ("Administration"), Article 3 ("Village

President") of the Oak Park Village Code to Add a New Section 2-3-5

("Order of Succession")

<u>Overview:</u> The Village Board's Protocols as adopted on October 7, 2019 pursuant to

Resolution Number 19-310 provides that in an emergency, the Village Manager

and/or Communications Director will work directly with the Village President/Mayor or President Pro-Tem (who is selected on seniority and

availability) if it is necessary for an elected official to serve as the

spokesperson for the Village Board. This ordinance is recommended to codify this Board protocol pursuant to Section 6 of the Emergency Interim Executive

Succession Act, 5 ILCS 275/6.
