ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS TECHNOLOGY AND HARDWARE EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF OAK PARK

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Oak Park ("Village"), it is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the Village, to retain the technology and hardware equipment described in Section 3 below; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Village to expeditiously donate the technology equipment set forth in Section 3 below pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:

- **Section 1. Recitals Incorporated.** The above recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance and shall have the same force and effect as though fully set forth herein.
- **Section 2. Technology Equipment No Longer Useful to the Village.** Pursuant to section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village finds that continued ownership of the technology and hardware equipment set forth in the list attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as <u>Exhibit A</u> is no longer necessary or useful to the Village or for the best interests of the Village to retain ownership.
- **Section 3. Donation of Technology and Hardware Equipment.** All Zoll Cardiac X Series cables, leads associated hardware and devices set forth in <u>Exhibit A</u> shall be donated to the Village of Forest Park who shall refurbish the equipment and distribute or recycle the equipment at no cost to the Village.
- **Section 4. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Oak Park are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.
- **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval, passage and publication as provided by law.
