An unbalanced Breakdown Schedule providing for overpayment of Consultant on component parts of the Services to be performed first will not be accepted. The Breakdown Schedule shall be revised and resubmitted until acceptable by the Village. No payment shall be made for Services until Consultant has submitted, and the Village has approved, an acceptable Breakdown Schedule.

The Village may require that the approved Breakdown Schedule be revised based on developments occurring during the provision and performance of the Services. If Consultant fails to submit a revised Breakdown Schedule that is acceptable to the Village, the Village shall have the right either to suspend Progress and Final Payments for Services or to make such Payments based on the Village's determination of the value of the Services completed.

For purposes of determining the amount to be paid to Consultant in the event of any termination pursuant to Section 4.3 of the Agreement, Direct Labor Costs and Reimbursable Expenses shall be according to the rates included in the Agreement.

Drainage Repairs at Oak Park Public Works Facility



PART I OVERVIEW

TranSystems will design a replacement for drainage for the wash bay which current system clogs and results in leaking water. We will consider the use of a trench drain to replace the existing floor drains. We do have some concerns about the feasibility of a trench drain being installed on the existing precast double t. The design will also include a catch basin or similar system to all for easy cleaning of drainage lines in the future
