REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)

Professional Land Surveying Services for the Establishment of Vertical Bench Mark Monuments

The Village of Oak Park ("the Village") is requesting qualifications to identify consultants to assure that it is receiving the optimum level of services at a competitive price.

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Section I. General Requirements

A. Introduction and Mandatory Terms

The Village requests the services of a qualified Consultant for the purpose of providing professional land surveying services to complete a Bench Mark survey to establish vertical monuments to the specified order of accuracy at locations throughout the Village of Oak Park. The locations of the proposed monuments determined by the consultant and dictated by ordered survey method specified. This project shall consist of:

- Establish (8) Bench Mark Monuments that shall meet 2nd order class 1 vertical standards within the Village of Oak Park.
- Establish monuments necessary for the above mentioned standards of differential leveling from distant existing monuments.
- Re-establish (2) existing Control Monuments that shall meet 2nd order class 1 (vertical only) survey standards.
- Tying approximately 16 existing hydrant Bench Marks and 2 Chicago City Datum (CCD) Bench Marks to the control survey using differential leveling.

The Village will receive responses Monday through Friday, 8:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. at the Office of the Village Engineer, Village of Oak Park, 201 South Blvd, Oak Park, Illinois, 60302. Each Consultant shall provide three (3) hard copies of their proposal and compensation schedule in a sealed envelope titled "RFP for Professional Land Surveying Services for the Establishment of Vertical and Horizontal Control Monuments".

All additional questions must be submitted via email to <u>ddonnelly@oak-park.us</u> no later than August 18, 2016. Responses will be provided to the known list of RFP recipients.

Responses will be reviewed and evaluated, and all information regarding status will be kept confidential until a decision is made and a recommendation provided to the Village Board for approval.

B. Presentation of Request for Qualifications

The Village reserves the right to select a short list of Consultants at its own discretion to present their qualifications, respond to questions, and supply supplemental information.

C. Consultant Notification

Consultants will be notified in writing of further questions and/or decisions.

D. Award of Agreement

An agreement or equivalent agreement may be executed once one or more respondents are found to be qualified, a selection of the most qualified is determined by the evaluation committee, and the Village Board approves of the award.

Any agreement with a selected Consultant or Consultants must be reviewed and approved by the Village Attorney, may be approved and authorized by the Village of Oak Park Board of Trustees, and executed by the Village Manager. The Consultants are advised that Village staff, other than the Village Manager, have no authority to sign agreements or modify existing agreements on behalf of the Village and that any such agreements are null and void.

E. Taxes Not Applicable

The Village as a municipality pays neither federal excise tax nor Illinois retailer's occupational tax.

F. Interpretation of the Request for Proposal Document

Any Consultant in doubt as to the true meaning of any part of this document may request an interpretation thereof from the Village or its representative. The person requesting the interpretation shall be responsible for its prompt delivery. At the request of the Consultant or in the event that Village management deems the interpretation to be substantive, the interpretation will be made by written addendum duly issued by the Village.

In the event that a written addendum is issued, either as a result of a request for interpretation or the result of a change in the requested RFP specifications initiated by the Village, a copy of such addendum will be provided to the known list of RFP recipients. The Village will not assume responsibility for receipt of such addendum. In all cases it will be the Consultants' responsibility to obtain all addenda issued.

G. Competency of Consultant

No submission will be accepted from, or agreement awarded to, any person, firm or corporation that is in arrears or is in default upon any debt or agreement. The Consultant, if requested, must present evidence of ability and possession of

necessary facilities, and financial resources to comply with the terms of the scope of services.

H. Subletting of Contract

In order that the Village may be assured that only qualified and competent subcontractors and/or sub-consultants will be employed on the proposed project, each consultant shall submit with their proposal a list of subcontractors and/or sub-consultants who would be called upon to perform the work. The consultant shall have determined to their own satisfaction that a listed subcontractor and/or sub-consultant has been successfully engaged in this particular type of work for a reasonable length of time and is qualified both technically and financially to perform that pertinent phase of the work for which they are listed.

No contract awarded by the Village of Oak Park shall be assigned or any part subcontracted without the written consent of the Village of Oak Park. In no case shall such consent relieve the bidder selected from their obligations or change the terms of the contract.

I. Compliance with Applicable Laws

The Consultant will strictly comply with all Ordinances and codes of the Village of Oak Park and applicable federal and state law.

J. Term of Agreement

The initial agreement shall be on the earlier of March 7, 2016, or the last date signed by both parties, whichever is later, and shall continue for an initial (approximately) one year period until the completion of all survey work associated with the Lake Street Streetscape and Local Street Improvement projects.

The Village retains the right to renew this initial agreement under the same terms and conditions upon mutual agreement with the Respondent. Renewals are to be done on a yearly basis for no more than two additional terms of approximately one year each. Price escalation will be allowed and subject to one (1) adjustment per period. The requested increase must be that of the general industry. In this event, written notification stating the requested increase and supporting document justification must be forwarded to the Village. The annual adjustment shall be based upon 100% of the percentage of change of the latest published Index (as defined below) as compared to the Index for the previous year. The Index shall be the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, Revised Consumer Price Index for all Urban Wage Earners for Chicago, Illinois - Gary, Indiana - Kenosha, Wisconsin (all items, 1982-84 = 100). Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, the annual adjustment shall not be greater than five percent (5%) of the previous year's cost for services provided under this agreement in any year. If the Respondent fails to justify the requested increase, the Village reserves the right to reject the request and cancel the balance of the agreement.

If any price reductions are announced during the agreement period, the Village shall receive benefit of such reductions. This request shall also be in the form of a written notification and shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date the notice was received by the Village.

K. Payments

The Village shall pay the consultant on a monthly basis based on the services provided during the month. Payment to the consultant shall be made within 30 days of the receipt of an invoice for services as outlined in the proposal. A detailed summary of costs will be submitted to the Village for review and approval. Total payments for each Phase shall not exceed the amount submitted on the Proposal Form, unless prior approval is received from the Village. Invoices shall be mailed to the Village Engineer located at the Village of Oak Park, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302. All invoices will be paid within 30 days of approval. Charges for late payments must be in accordance with the Local Government Prompt Payment Act, 50 ILCS 505/1, requiring a maximum interest penalty of 1% per month or portion thereof.

L. Termination of Contract

The Village reserves the right to terminate any multi-year agreement if the Village's Board of Trustees fails to appropriate funds for this purpose in any subsequent fiscal year. All funds for payments after December 31st of the current fiscal year are subject to appropriation by the Village for this purpose.

The Village further reserves the right to terminate the whole or any part of this agreement, upon written notice to the consultant, in the event of default by the consultant. Default is defined as failure of the consultant to perform any of the agreement or failure to make sufficient progress so as to endanger performance of this agreement in accordance with its terms. In the event of default and termination, the Village will procure upon such terms and in such manner as may be deemed appropriate services similar to those so terminated. The consultant shall be liable for excess costs for such similar services unless acceptable evidence is submitted that failure to perform the agreement was due to causes beyond the control and without the fault of negligence of the consultant.

M. Consultant Personnel Assigned to the Village of Oak Park Account(s)

The Village reserves the right to accept or reject any staff designated by the Consultant to provide surveying services. If no suitable replacement staff is provided, the Village reserves the right to terminate the agreement.

N. Confidentiality

The Consultant shall keep the Village's employee and all related data confidential.

O. Insurance Requirements

The selected Consultant must purchase and maintain for the length of the agreement, the lines of insurance described in this section. All insurance coverage shall be on an occurrence basis. The Consultant shall provide evidence of such insurance to the Village together with its proposal, and will provide evidence that the Village has been added as a named insured, where applicable, before commencement of the services and on an annual basis thereafter. Certificates of Insurance shall contain a clause stating that the coverage afforded by the policies listed will not be canceled or materially altered, except after forty-five (45) days advance written notice to the Village. The Consultant shall secure the following endorsements to each of the required policies: "It is understood and agreed that the insurance company will give not less than forty-five (45) days advance written notice of any cancellation or material change under any of these policies to the Village of Oak Park. "In the event that such notice is not given to the Village of Oak Park at least forty-five (45) days prior to cancellation or material change, the policy will continue in full force and effect for the benefit of the Village as if such change or cancellation had not occurred." The limits of liability for the insurance required shall provide coverage for not less than the following amounts, or greater where required by law:

(a) Commercial General Liability:

i. Coverage to include, Broad Form Property Damage, contractual and Personal Injury.

iii. Coverage for all claims arising out of the Proposer's operations or premises, anyone directly or indirectly employed by the Proposer.

(b) **Professional Liability:**

Per Claim/Aggregate

ii. Coverage for all claims arising out of the Consultant's operations or premises, anyone directly or indirectly employed by the Consultant, and the Consultant's obligations under the indemnification provisions of this Agreement to the extent same are covered.

(c) Workers' Compensation:

i. Workers' compensation insurance shall be in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, including occupational disease provisions, for all employees who perform work pursuant to the agreement, and in case work is subcontracted, the Consultant shall require each subconsultant similarly to provide Workers' Compensation Insurance. In case employees engaged in hazardous work under this Agreement are not protected under said worker's compensation insurance, the Proposer shall provide, and shall cause

each subconsultant to provide, adequate and suitable insurance for the protection of employees not otherwise provided.

(d) Comprehensive Automobile Liability:

i. Coverage to include all owned, hired, non-owned vehicles, and/or trailers and other equipment required to be licensed, covering personal injury, bodily injury and property damage.

ii. Limits:

Combined Single Limit \$1,000,000.00

(e) Umbrella:

i. Limits:

Each Occurrence/Aggregate \$2,000,000.00

(f) The Village, its officers, officials, employees and agents shall be named as additional insureds on all insurance policies set forth herein except Workers' Compensation and Professional Liability. The Consultant shall be responsible for the payment of any deductibles for said insurance policies. The coverage shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection afforded to the Village, its officers, officials, employees and agents.

The Consultant understands and agrees that any insurance protection required by the agreement or otherwise provided by the Consultant shall in no way limit the responsibility to indemnify, keep and save harmless, and defend the Village, its officers, officials, employees and agents as herein provided.

P. Hold Harmless and Indemnity

Notwithstanding any limitations or restrictions applicable to any insurance or bonds required hereunder, the Consultant shall defend, indemnify and hold the Village of Oak Park and its officers, officials, employees, and agents harmless from and against any and all liability, loss, damage, claim, payment or expense, including attorney fees, which the Village or its officers, officials, employees, and agents may incur resulting from or arising out of any error or omission in the performance of the agreement by the Consultant, including, without limitation, errors or omissions in the handling, accounting for, or transferring of funds, or to work, services or systems or products provided in the performance of the agreement by the Consultant or its employees, agents, servants, associates, Consultants, sub-consultants, or assignees.

R. Proposal Outline

Proposals are requested to cover the basic services related to Control surveying as described in the scope of services section. The Village reserves the right during the term of the agreement to request additional services in addition to those specified in the Proposal form with payment for those additional services to be mutually agreed upon between the Village and the consultant.

Proposals shall include the following information:

- A. A brief description of the consultant's capabilities, strengths and relevant experience.
- B. A team organization chart indicating the staff and their areas of involvement.
- C. List other contracts awarded to consultant most comparable to the work described in the scope of services. Please provide contact name, address and telephone number. Also, provide contract costs associated with each project.
- D. Include a description of survey methods and equipment which will be used for establishing 2nd order class I monuments.
- E. Any objections to any terms of the request for proposal.

T. Failure to Complete Work on Time

Should the Consultant fail to complete and deliver the work according to the tentative schedule, the Consultant shall be liable to pay the Village of Oak Park liquidated damages according to Section 108.09 of the Illinois Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction Adopted January 1, 2016. Extensions of contract time shall be according to Section 108.08 of the Illinois Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction Adopted January 1, 2016.

Section II. Scope of Services

The Village of Oak Park is seeking a land surveying company to complete a Bench Mark Survey Network. The scope of services shall consist of performing a NGS Vertical control survey:

- A) Install eight (8) Bench Mark Monuments at locations somewhat evenly dispersed throughout the Village of Oak Park. These monuments shall be established to meet 2nd order class 1 vertical only surveying standards.
- B) Verify and update two (2) existing Control Monuments meeting 2nd order class 1 vertical only surveying standards.
- C) In addition to establishing 10 Bench Mark monuments, the consultant shall tie approximately 16 existing hydrant benchmarks into the differential level loops. Also, 2 CCD monuments shall be tied by differential leveling.
 - A list of hydrant bench marks and location of CCD monuments will be provided by the Village.
- D) Establish the Horizontal location of the 10 Bench Mark Monuments to State Plane Coordinates (Illinois East) using RTK GPS (no order specified).

It is intended that the eight (8) new monuments shall be published as NGS monuments.

There are six (6) existing NGS monuments that could be used for this Bench Mark Survey. They are:

ME 1788-just north of Midway Airport (1st order Class II) 5 miles south of VOP

ME 1783–1 mile west of Midway (1st order Class I) 1 mile west if ME 1788

ME 1649 - just north of North Ave (1st order Class I) 100' north of VOP

ME 1657 - 75th Ave & Grand Ave (1st order Class I) 1 mile north & .5 mile west of VOP

ME 1659—Webster Ave & Grand Ave (1st order Class I) .6 mile nw of ME 1657

ME 1661-Grand Ave and Des Plaines River (1st order Class I) 1 mile nw of ME 1659

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR THIS PROPOSAL

1. All monument elevations shall be given in NAVD 88 to be reported and submitted to be published as NGS Second Order Class I Benchmarks.

The Village of Oak Park currently uses Chicago City Datum (CCD) for Capital Improvement Projects. The Village will require the consultant to tie new monuments with CCD monuments and hydrant benchmarks. The consultant shall then compute and list measured and adjusted CCD elevations of these benchmarks and the new monuments.

Elevations (CCD) shall be given to the nearest thousandth (0.001).

2. Field Procedures

- a. Field work shall be performed in accordance with accepted technical methods as expressed in standard handbooks on control surveying theory, practice and procedures (specifically NGS –NOAA manual).
- b. The person in charge of the survey field party shall be a Professional Land Surveyor in the State of Illinois, in good standing with the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, and well-trained in the technical aspects of surveying.
- 3. J.U.L.I.E. (1-800-892-0123) must be contacted with at least 48 hour notice prior to setting the monuments.
- 4. The Surveyor shall provide a copy of all field books, notes, and calculations used to determine the final elevations of all bench marks.
- 5. The official survey monument descriptions, sketches, field notes and the benchmark elevations shall be furnished to the Village on CD-ROM and as a hard-copy paper report. Data from the vertical control survey shall be provided to the Village in a Microsoft Excel spreadsheet. The format of the spreadsheet will be determined later.
- 6. The survey method to be used:

The differential leveling shall be the primary method for the vertical component of Vertical Control survey.

<u>SPECIFICATIONS FOR INSTALLING MONUMENTS</u>

This item will consist of installing sleeved Class A Rod Markers.

- 1. Rod marks shall be Class A Deep Rod Stainless Steel with a Floating Sleeve.
- The installation and material used should conform to the Standards and diagrams found in the NOAA's Manual NOS NGS 1 for Geodetic Bench Marks.
- 3. The specific location for setting the monument will be made at the discretion of consultant and Village engineering staff.
- 4. The flange seated at the top of the monument casement shall be stamped with the station's designation, year and the letters VOP. The concrete markers shall be stamped with the station's designation, year and the letters VOP.

BASIS OF PAYMENT:

The item will be paid for PER MILE (end to end), which shall be payment in full for recon, research, monument setting, field work, computations, processing and submittal of Bench Mark data to NGS. This shall also include all labor, materials, transportation, handling and incidental work necessary to install and establish the monuments specified herein. Measuring (tying in), calculating and adjusting the 16 hydrant and 2 CCD bench marks shall be considered incidental to the project.

The Village will evaluate aggregate services based on the overall cost effective approach to providing the services requested in this RFP.

F. Optional Interviews and/or Site Visits
