

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) FOR A STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT FOR THREE NEW FIREFIGHTERS/PARAMEDICS

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, State of Illinois (“Village”), in the exercise of their home rule powers, that the Village is authorized to submit an application with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant for three NEW firefighters/paramedics and the Village Manager or the Village Manager’s designee is authorized to execute any and all documents in furtherance of the application and grant.
