Description of Work

Name: Resurfacing of Various Streets

Location: Various Streets in Oak Park IL

Proposed Improvement: In general, the improvements consist of the removal and replacement of curb and gutter, sidewalks, driveways, drainage structure adjustments, pavement patching, cold milling of bituminous concrete, installation of hot-mix asphalt binder and surface courses, parkway restoration, and all appurtenant work thereto.

Bidders Instructions

1. Plans and proposal forms will be available in the Office of the Village Engineer, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois 60302 upon payment of **\$40.00** (non-refundable). No plans will be issued to prospective bidders after **4 P.M.** on the working day preceding the opening of bids. Proposals will not be accepted by the Village of Oak Park from Contractors who have failed to provide payment, if required, for obtaining proposal forms and have also failed to register with the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department as plan holders for this project.
2. At the bid opening, all proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty, executed by a corporate surety company (bid bond) or a bank cashier's check in the amount of 5% of the amount bid.

3. The awarding authority reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals as provided in Article 102.01 of the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction," prepared by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

2. The plans for the proposed work are those prepared by the Engineering Division of the Village of Oak Park, 201 South Boulevard, Oak Park, Illinois on February 16, 2017.
3. The specifications referred to herein are those prepared by the Department of Transportation and designated as "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" and the "Supplemental Specifications" thereto, adopted and in effect on the date of invitation of bids.
4. The undersigned agrees to accept, as part of the contract, the applicable Special Provisions indicated on the "Check Sheet for Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions" contained in this proposal.
5. The undersigned agrees to all Project work before the final completion date of July 22, 2017 unless additional time is granted in accordance with the specifications.
6. Accompanying this proposal is either a bid bond on the Village Bond form or a proposal guaranty check, complying with the specifications, made payable to the Village of Oak Park. The amount of the check is 5% Bid Bond (\$ 5%).
7.
