3. The specifications referred to herein are those prepared by the Department of Transportation and designated as "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" and the "Supplemental Specifications" there to, adopted and in effect on the date of invitation of bids.
4. The undersigned agrees to accept, as part of the contract, the applicable Special Provisions indicated on the "Check Sheet for Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions" contained in this proposal.
5. The undersigned shall submit proof of Illinois Department of Transportation pre-qualification.
6. **The undersigned agrees to complete work by July 14, 2017, unless additional time is granted in accordance with the specifications.**
7. Accompanying this proposal is either a bid bond on Village Bond form, or a proposal guaranty check, complying with the specifications, made payable to the Village of Oak Park. The amount of the check is Five Percent Bid Bond (\$ 5%).
8. If this proposal is accepted and the undersigned fails to execute a contract and contract bond within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award or within such extended period as the Village may grant if the Contract Bond does not meet its approval shall constitute a default, and the Village may either award the Contract to the next lowest responsible proposer or re-advertise for proposals. 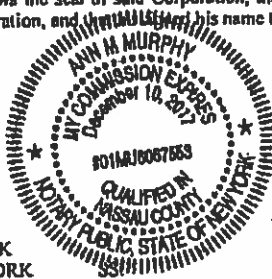
