A RESOLUTION RAISING THE MINIMUM HOUR REQUIREMENT TO 1000 HOURS FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS (VILLAGE PRESIDENT) IN THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Park is a participant in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, elected officials may participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund if they are in positions normally requiring performance of duty for 1000 hours or more per year; and

WHEREAS, this government body can determine what the normal annual hourly requirements of its elected officials are, and should make such determination for the guidance and direction of the Board of Trustees of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park find that the following elected position requires performance of duty of 1000 hours or more per year to qualify for membership in IMRF:
