

5.0 Understanding of Survey Methods

There are a few technical directives or specifications that were mentioned in the proposal that we would like to reiterate to show our understanding:

We understand the project can be under contract as early as October 16, 2017. The first milestone is scheduled for December 15, 2017 to provide final drawings of the Local Streets for Capital Improvement Projects, Phase I. The second milestone is on March 9, 2018 for delivery of the final drawings of Local Streets Phase II. This schedule will be contingent on the weather as we foresee that some of the fieldwork will be done in the cold winter months.

It is understood that the topographic survey should be taken at 50 foot cross sections as well as at midpoint of curve returns, driveways, and drainage structures. The cross sections should obtain all critical breaking features such as pavement, flowline, back of curb, sidewalk, and 7 feet from edge of pavement and curb face. The surveys will utilize benchmarks provided by the Village that are referenced to City of Chicago Datum and will utilize Illinois State Plane Coordinates (East Zone, NAD83) for the coordinate datum.

The RFP also mentions the need to represent the ROW of the road. Patrick will refer to available road way plans, subdivision plats, and tax maps to verify the road widths of the roads and alleys and correlate that to found evidence in the field. We are not producing a Plat of Highway nor are we providing a signature and seal for a Boundary Survey.



6.0 Objections to any terms of the request for proposal.

Below we have taken excerpts from the provided terms of the proposal and added some comments or items to be stricken.

0. Insurance Requirements

except for professional liability insurance which shall be on a claims made basis

The selected Consultant must purchase and maintain for the length of the agreement, the lines of insurance described in this section. All insurance coverage shall be on an occurrence basis! The Consultant shall provide evidence of such insurance to the Village together with its proposal, and will provide evidence that the Village has been added as a named insured, where applicable, before commencement of the services and on an annual basis thereafter. Certificates of Insurance shall contain a clause stating that the coverage afforded by the policies listed will not be canceled or materially altered, except after forty-five (45) days advance written notice to the Village. The Consultant shall secure the following endorsements to each of the required policies: "It is understood and agreed that the insurance company will give not less than forty-five (45) days advance written notice of any cancellation or material change under any of these policies to the Village of Oak Park. "In the event that such notice is not given to the Village of Oak Park at least forty-five (45) days prior to cancellation or material change, the policy will continue in full force and effect for the benefit of the Village as if such change or cancellation had not occurred." The limits of liability for the insurance required shall provide coverage for not less than the following amounts, or greater where required by law:

Notwithstanding any limitations or restrictions applicable to any insurance or bonds required hereunder, the Consultant shall defend, indemnify and hold the Village of Oak Park and its officers, officials, employees, and egents harmless from and against any and all liability, loss, damage, claim, payment or expense, including attorney fees, which the Village or its officers, officials, employees, and agents may incur resulting from or arising out of any error or omission in the performance of the agreement by the Consultant, including, without limitation, errors or omissions in the handling, accounting for, or transferring of funds, or to work, services or eyetems or products provided in the performance of the agreement by the Consultant or its employees, agents, servants, associates, Consultants, sub-consultants, or assignees.

T. Failure to Complete Work on Time

Should the Consultant fail to complete and deliver the work according to the tentative schedule, the Consultant shall be liable to pay the Village of Oak Park liquidated damages according to Section 108.09 of the Illinois Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction Adopted January 1, 2016. Extensions of contract time shall be according to Section 108.08 of the Illinois Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction Adopted January 1, 2016.

The above item is asked to be stricken since unless there can be leniency in extending the schedule due to weather concerns such as rain, cold, ice, and wind chill. These are factors that are outside of our control that can impact our schedule.

7.0 Pricing

Patrick has provided our pricing per the provided format in Section III Compensation Estimate Schedule. We are bidding a fee of \$29,744.93 for the Local Roads Capital Improvement Project.

8.0 Addendums


