ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REMOVING LOT 119 WITH EIGHT (8) PARKING SPACES ON PLEASANT PLACE AS A VILLAGE PERMIT PARKING LOT AND ESTABLISHING EIGHT (8) GENERAL PARKING SPACES IN THE FORMER LOT 119 SUBJECT ONLY TO THE OVERNIGHT PARKING BAN

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance Number 1988-O-58, as amended by Ordinance Numbers 1994-O-69, 1995-O-68, 2004-O-07, 2005-O-22, 2008-O-10, 2008-O-50, 2009-O-57 and 2011-O-23, 2017-183 the Village of Oak Park ("Village") authorized certain on-street overnight permit parking along street frontages in areas zoned R-7 Multiple-Family District; and

WHEREAS, the Village's Transportation Commission conducted a parking study in the for the area from Harlem Avenue to Oak Park Avenue and South Boulevard to Harrison Street ("Area") and recommended that a new Lot 119 be established with eight (8) parking spaces with 24 hour parking permits for area residents; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees concurred with the Transportation Commission's recommendation and adopted Ordinance Number 2017-183 establishing Lot 119; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, at its meeting of August 28, 2017, the Transportation Commission recommended the removal of Lot 119 as a Village permit parking lot and the establishment of eight (8) general parking spaces in the former Lot 119 subject to only to the overnight parking ban; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees concurs with the Transportation Commission's recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:

- **Section 1. Recitals Incorporated.** The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth.
- **Section 2.** Removal of Lot 119 as a Village Permit Parking Lot. Lot 119 is removed as a Village permit parking lot and eight (8) general parking are established in the former Lot 119 subject to only to the overnight parking ban.
- **Section 3. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval, passage and publication as provided by law.
