#### **Parking Meter Rates**

Dynamic pricing Mon-Sat, 8am-8pm: \$1/hour for first 3 hours and \$3/hour after. No parking 2:30am-6:00 am without a permit/pass. Free on Sundays.



#### **Simplified Parking Zone**

Four main streets create a border in an easy to identify zone. Simple and consistent rules throughout the parking pilot zone.



# **Parking Time Limits**

Non-permitted vehicles are restricted to a 3-hour limit on residential blocks between 8am-8pm. No parking from 2:30am-6am without a permit or pass.

Open Parking on Sundays.



## **Residential Parking Permits**

Day permit costs \$70 annually, for residents within the parking pilot zone. Night permit costs \$540 annually, for residents within the parking pilot zone.



# **Resident Guest Parking (Passes)**

Guests park for 24 hours, using mobile pass platform.

Thirty (30) free passes per plate, per year, within the parking pilot zone.

Additional \$7 each, for 24 hours, using mobile payment platform.

Must be a guest of parking pilot zone resident.



## **Employee On-Street Parking Permits**

Expanded employee parking options for businesses, employees, care providers, trades people, and other service providers, on East/West streets, within the parking pilot zone.



#### **Street Cleaning**

Restrictions in place for street cleaning on one specific day, per each side of the street, every week. For example: No parking Monday 8am-1pm, on all south streets.



#### Streamlined Enforcement

License plate recognition technology will be used to effectively enforce parking restrictions.
