## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OAK PARK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER 97 TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE HARVARD STREET TO WESTBOUND TRAFFIC BETWEEN CUYLER AVENUE AND RIDGELAND AVENUE TWO TIMES PER DAY ON SCHOOL DAYS <u>PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-4-1 OF THE OAK PARK VILLAGE CODE</u>

WHEREAS, Section 22-4-1 of the Oak Park Village Code provides that a Village of Oak Park ("Village") street may be encumbered or encroached pursuant to a duly adopted ordinance or resolution by the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined to authorize Oak Park Elementary School District Number 97 to encumber and encroach Harvard Street two (2) times per day on days when school is in session at Washington Irving Elementary School in the Village as set forth herein.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Park, Cook County, State of Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:

**Section 1. Recitals Incorporated.** The above recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

Section 2. Authorization to Temporarily Close Harvard Street to Westbound Traffic. Oak Park Elementary School District Number 97 ("School District") and its employees and agents are hereby authorized to temporarily close Harvard Street to westbound traffic between Cuyler Avenue and Ridgeland Avenue two (2) times per day on days when school is in session at Washington Irving Elementary School located at 1125 South Cuyler Avenue, Oak Park, Illinois pursuant to Section 22-4-1 of the Oak Park Village Code.

**Section 3.** Number of Temporary Closures. The total number of said temporary closures shall not exceed two (2) per school day.

**Section 4.** Length of Temporary Closures. Each temporary closure authorized herein shall not exceed thirty (30) minutes in length.

**Section 5.** Placement and Removal of Barricades. The placement and removal of street barricades by the School District shall be subject to all rules, regulations and orders of the Village's Director of Public Works or the Director's designee.

Section 6. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances, Resolutions and Motions. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this resolution. All

ordinances, resolutions or adopted motions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 7. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage as provided by law.
