QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1) Would you consider this a design/build?

- The Village is interested in receiving proposals for design services. Sign Design should be included as an Alternative Bid. All design files must be transferred to the Village in a commonly readable format for future use by Village staff.
- If proposing design services, ensure that the specs follow the design standards as found in the current MUTCD sign manual found at this website:
https://mutcd.fhwa.dot.gov/ser-shs_millennium.htm
- In the absence of a design proposal, the Village will provide sign designs. The signs proposed for the area include:
 - i. 3-Hour Parking, 8AM to 8PM, Monday-Friday.
 - ii. No Parking XXXX For Street Cleaning.
 - iii. Night Permit Parking Only
 - iv. Pay-by-Plate Parking
 - v. Others possible, TBD

2) What is the total amount of square feet of signage?

- Typical parking signs in Oak Park are 12" x 18", but sizes may range up to 12" x 36", and the Village would consider 18" wide signs for this pilot.
- There are an estimated 1,200 to 1,700 parking regulation signs in the pilot area currently. Many of these will be replaced with an updated sign, one-for-one, while some will be consolidated.

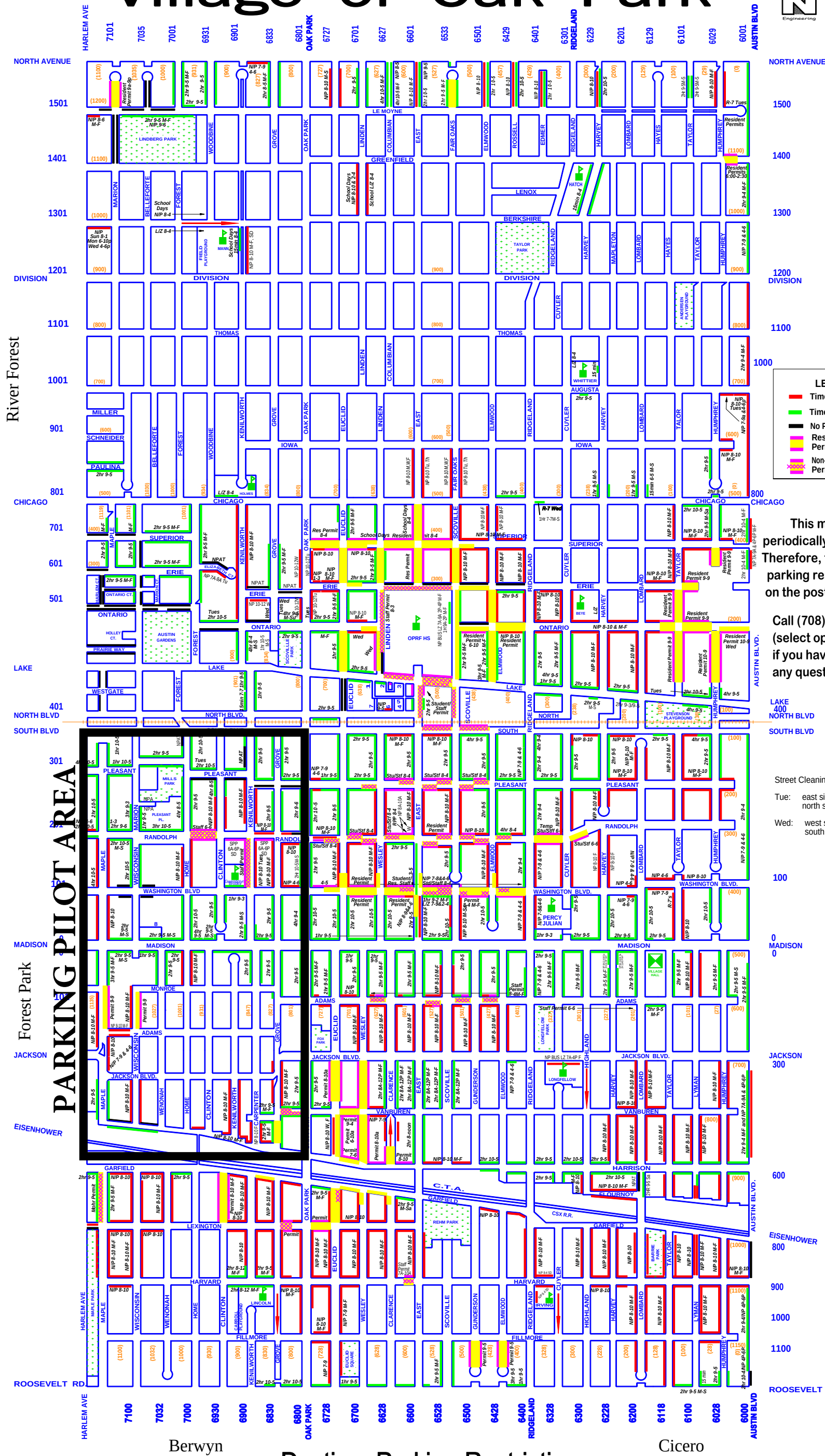
3) What is the total amount of lineal feet of posts?

- It is not known what the total lineal feet of posts required will be. It is the Village's intention to use existing posts wherever possible and reduce the need to install new posts, keeping total lineal feet of new posts to a minimum.

- 4) What are the designs for the signs that will be needed? (Or currently existing signs)
 - See answer to Question 1.
- 5) What type sheeting is required for the signage?
 - Diamond Grade Cubed sheeting
- 6) Do you have a map?
 - See attached map and outlined "Parking Pilot Area". This map shows curbs with daytime restrictions, which will all be standardize with this project to 3-hour parking Monday-Friday. All curbs noted to have daytime restrictions will thus have signage updated to reflect the new restriction.
 - Permits, Pay-by-Plate Parking, and Street Cleaning signs may also be required to be updated within the Parking Pilot Area.
- 7) Is there a cost estimate or budget available for this project?
 - The Village is not able to provide a cost estimate or budget.
- 8) What type of banding is to be used?
 - Standard stainless steel banding, except for on black decorative poles, in which case black colored banding is to be used
